Conference Identification

With the registration materials each participant will receive a conference wristband and a conference t-shirt. The wristband is to be used to enter all sanctioned activities at the Ontario Convention Center and the Toyota Arena.

Delegates, State Officer Candidates, Nominating Committee Members and Special Guests will receive a conference badge and lanyard. This badge will allow access to the Toyota Arena floor. Participants must have a badge to gain admittance to the arena floor.

One day participants will receive a colored wristband for the day they are participating in the Conference. This wristband will allow entrance to all sanctioned events on the specific day.

All credentials will be included in the Chapter Registration packet.
